Account Balance: approx \$7000

Fundraisers and success with each discussed:

Pan Fundraiser: We sold around 375 items and made \$2400
Since our fundraiser remains open through the end of the year, we will possibly have another round of sales in the fall.

Yardsale: Was successful, took little effort and made around \$350. We plan to have another fundraiser in the fall, right after school starts.

Face-Painting: Made \$250 and we plan to do again in the fall. All the kids enjoyed this fundraiser

McDonalds pancake dinner: We made between \$400 and \$500 dollars and did not take too much effort, however, we will be going to try the Burger King fundraiser next year. For that fundraiser, we work 3-8 at Burger King and we get 10% of the sales that night.

Turkeys: This year's turkey fundraiser with Great Boars made about \$500 which was similar to what we have made in the past. However, we sold less turkeys because they were frozen. We would like to use Hoggy's as we have done in previous years because we prefer the hot turkeys on Thanksgiving Day. If Hoggy's is not available, we will not do a turkey fundraiser next year.

Santa pictures: We made a little more than \$200 for the pictures. We will continue to do this fundraiser since the kids enjoy it.

Since we did not make as much as usual this year due to the lack of the catalog fundraiser, we will plan to do a catalog fundraiser next year, sometime in the spring.

We also discussed selling shirts, umbrella or cinch-sacks next year. Becky said that Attitudes design would work with us in selling these types of items.
