

## PTO 11/10/09 Minutes

Amy opened the meeting discussing Fall Fundraiser.

Fall Fundraiser total sales were \$14,362 with our profit around \$7,000 as we get approximately half of sales. The tentative date for delivery of sale items in November 18<sup>th</sup>.

On delivery day, students from Jr High studyhall will help distribute the items to students. One adult is requested to help at the Jr High. 2 adults are needed at Lincoln. Distribution usually takes around an hour, Amy will be at the school that day and will notify the volunteers of time to be at the school to help.

Fun Day at each school is the reward from the Fall Fundraiser. Fun day(s) will be the week of Thanksgiving with Lincoln's day on Tuesday and Davie/Jr High day on Wednesday.

-There will be a bounce house at the Lincoln gym, and the bounce house and obstacle course at the Jr High old gym. Jimmy Prater will be setting up the bounce house each day. Total cost to rent the bounce house is \$550.

-No PTO volunteers needed on these days, as teachers will sign their class up for a time slot on their fun day and will supervise their own class.

-There was a discussion of changing the bounce to the slide bounce house for Lincoln school.

-Question regarding Nikki Hadley providing a popcorn machine for the events – need follow-up.

Kroger card fundraiser has been approved. Karen Clark has submitted the application to Kroger and is awaiting approval by Kroger. Once approved, PTO will need to order the cards to sell; cards will come to Kroger store for pickup and should be paid for at that time.

#### Teacher Requests:

Extended Day has requested PTO donate \$50 per month to cover costs of snacks for children. They are currently asking parents for donations, but would like to be able to purchase snacks for the kids.

Nicolle Frick requested approx \$120 to purchase a subscription to Microbes magazine. The cost would cover copies for 30 students and resource book for the teacher.
